Old Business:

1. 2023 Budget approval DLGF 1782 notice: There were a few lines that were reduced due to the levy.
2. PERF issue: There were some issues about the Trustee participating in PERF. This issue has been resolved.

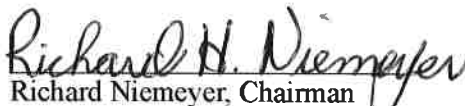
New Business:

1. Centier ATM rental/lease: The rent increased by \$100.00 per month, from \$400.00 to \$500.00. for another year.
2. 2023 Fire Contract: Much discussion took place regarding the contract and territory coverage. Keith will make the changes and present it to the Fire department and the Town Council. Adam made motion to defer the contract. Maralynn seconded. All in favor motion carried.
3. Update to Employee manual: It was never stated what percentage of the premium the employee should pay. She is currently paying 13%. Her policy has changed lowering the premium, but increasing the deductible and co-pay. Some discussion took place. Maralynn made motion to decrease her portion to 12% and to include it in the Employee handbook. Adam seconded. All in favor-motion carried.

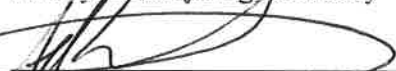
Any and All:
