Roll call was taken:

Minutes of previous meeting were read.

Old Business:

1. Email from Kurt Ott (Local Government Finance) regarding EMS & Fire funds. Rate reduced when assessed value goes up. We are at our maximum levy for these funds.

2. Investments - Kevin took \$100,000. from Rainy Day & \$100,000. from Cum Fire for investing purposes.

New Business:

1. Approve 2019 Annual Report some discussion took place. Maralynn made motion to accept. Adam seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

Any and All:

Discussion on a letter from Fire Chief, Todd Wilkening. He states that the station is not equipped to properly clean their gear after a fire. He gave us a list of what they would need. He states that he's out of money in his budget. Kevin was going to suggest he go to the Town Council first. The total for all he needs/wants is \$19,511. After much discussion, we agreed to look into the purchase of the washer & dryer. Not your typical appliances. Need to check around for different companies for pricing.

We also received a 2019 report of Hanover Township response breakdown. Along with a breakdown of calls from Jan - Dec 2019.
