

Hanover Township Board Meeting

Wednesday July 2nd, 2025

A meeting of the Hanover Township board was called to order at 6:03 p.m followed by a prayer offered by Richard Niemeyer, and the pledge of allegiance recited by all.

Roll call as follows: Board members present Richard Niemeyer, President. Marilyn Kaper, Secretary. Absent was Charles Kortokrax, Vice president. A quorum was established.

Also in attendance were Trustee Kevin Toth, Chief Deputy, Terri Blagojevic, Secretary, Beth Tate and Attorney, Adam Sedia.

Richard made a motion to accept previous minutes from June 4th, 2025. Marilyn seconded the motion. All in favor motion carries 2-0.

OLD BUSINESS- Ambulance Is ready to be picked up after repairs have been made. Radios will be in the next week or so.

NEW BUSINESS- Legislative Senate bill updates. Capital improvement plan will need to be submitted to Lake County council and department of local government. Lake county council needs it by August 7th and Department of local government is due by September 30th 2025. Kevin stated that we will need to have board approval on road fund soon. The board will need to adopt a resolution for a road and infrastructure fund.

Fire department reports were read from Cedar Lake. Saint Johns reports were not in. Richard Niemeyer accepted them as a matter of record.

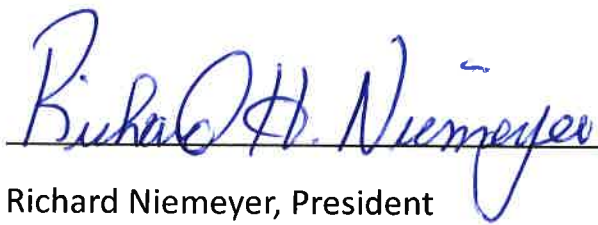
Discussion took place regarding our fire levy. Richard Niemeyer asked if we could prepare figures of the impact to the taxpayers if they approve the max levy.
